TEHALEH STREET TREE REPLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Per Pierce County, street trees need to be a minimum of 6' from flow line of the gutter/rolled curb. In a 7' wide planter strip (which is the case with most planter strips in Tehaleh's neighborhoods) the street trees need to be 1' (or less) from the front edge of sidewalk in order to meet Pierce County's requirements. In a 6' wide or less planter strip, the street trees need to be behind sidewalk.

A root barrier is also required for all street trees in the planter strips.

Street trees shall have uniform branching height of 5.5' minimum above grade or as otherwise noted on the approved Street Tree Plans.
